

ABOUT THE COURSE

This eight (8) day online short course will focus on 'Health Systems Strengthening (HSS) towards Universal Health Coverage (UHC)'. The short course theme has been divided into four interrelated sub-themes: (i) Overview: Governance, (ii) Overview: Health Governance, (iii) Health Governance: Standards and Practices, and (iv) Health Governance: Ground Realities and Way Forward. The course is a part of the SIDA funded project titled "Making Bangladesh's Healthcare Systems More Responsive and Participatory". Experiential learning (learning by doing) methodologies will be used to deliver the course lessons. The short course is designed for heath care practitioners, programme/policy planners and managers in the government, NGO, and private sector.
