3. Then you will have to identify the **ACTIONS** required to make necessary changes in the systems;
4. Then you will need to identify the **ROLES** (who will do what; primary & supportive) in performing every identified actions; and
5. Thereafter, you will need to set the **TIMELINE** to accomplish every planned actions.
